ASSESSING YOUR PROGRAMS

How do we assess your programs for SMSF Association Accreditation?

The awarding of CPD is done in line with the CPD Policy and Education Standards. The SMSF Association CPD Policy can be found [here](#).

The following outlines the SMSF Association education standards that are applied:

- 1A - Introduction to Superannuation and Self-Managed Superannuation Funds
- 2A - Establishing a Self-Managed Superannuation Fund
- 3A - Identify and Develop Investment Objectives and Strategies
- 4A - Identify and advise on taxation requirements for Self-Managed Superannuation
- 5A - Manage the administration and operational requirements of Self-Managed Super Funds to meet compliance obligations.
- 6A - Understand and apply all relevant legislation and case law, and all regulatory body interpretation of the law.
- 7A - Products managed within Self-Managed Superannuation Funds
- 8A - Competencies and Professional Requirements for SMSF Practitioners

You are required to submit with your application the following resources to support the CPD review process:

1. Marketing materials
2. PD Agenda/timetable
3. Link(s) to the marketing of the PD program
4. Biography of the presenter(s) demonstrating SMSF and content expertise
5. PowerPoint slides demonstrating how the content will be delivered with notes (if applicable)
6. Resources including handouts provided, quizzes or assessments undertaken
7. Link to the recording in the case of webinars
8. Link and access to online education materials
9. Evidence of the quality review process that your organisation uses for program materials and assessment
10. A copy of the participant feedback form

Your PD program is independently reviewed and benchmarked against the SMSF Association education standards, together with the FASEA CPD categories and standards.

CPD hours are awarded for the duration of each PD program where they meet the SMSF Association education standards.

The PD program is then awarded SMSF knowledge area (where applicable to each session), together with CPD hours in line with the SMSF Association CPD policy.

It is also awarded FASEA CPD categories (if applicable) and FASEA CPD hours where appropriate.

A CPD Accreditation Report is then issued to the organisation which provides the approval code and any special conditions (if applicable), together with the details of how the CPD has been awarded to PD program.

Conditions of CPD accreditation

When marketing the PD program, you must base this on the CPD accreditation report provided by the SMSF Association.

When issuing the CPD certificates at the completion of the program, you must include the accreditation approval code and also the appropriate CPD hours depending on the participants' attendance. Full records must be kept of the CPD certificates issued.

In line with FASEA standards, you **must** provide an overview of the PD program together with learning outcomes for each session.
