FASEA has updated their requirements in order for you to continue to provide advice as a financial planner.

- By 1 January 2026, all existing advisers will be required to raise their qualifications by completing an approved bachelor degree or higher (or equivalent).
- By 1 January 2022, all advisers will be required to pass a national examination.
